Study visits/peer learning: Online and face-to-face study visits with peer learning activities will take place during the project, aiming to the exchange of knowledge and best practices.



Implementation plans: The project will develop Implementation, with road maps towards new cooperation mechanisms for the successful implementation of Upskilling Pathways,



Kick off meeting & Study Visit in Croatia

The official launch of the project took place from January 31st to February 2nd, 2023, marked by the Kick-off meeting and a study visit held in Zagreb, Croatia. The event provided a platform for project partners to convene, fostering discussions on the coordination of various activities. Additionally, partners had the chance to explore Obrtničko učiliste, an adult education institution in Zagreb, which is dedicated to bridging vocational education with economic and regional development and to become familiarized with the status of Upskilling Pathways in Croatia.
